

Marina Andreeva graduated from Lomonosov Moscow State University (MSU) in 1969 and became Doctor of Science in 1991. She is a leading researcher at the Solid State Chair, Faculty of Physics, MSU. She is an author of several textbooks (in Russian) "Mössbauer gamma optiks"(1982) "Mössbauer and X-ray optics of a surface" (1996) (in collaboration with Prof. Kuz'min R.N.), "Nuclear resonant investigations with synchrotron radiation" (2019).
