

**Jean-Marc Greneche** is CNRS research director at the Institut des Molécules et Matériaux du Mans (IMMM UMR CNRS 6283) at Le Mans University (France). He obtained a PhD in Physics in 1987, was a Humboldt fellow in Karlsruhe in 1988 (Germany), was Editor at Journal of Alloys and Compounds, director of the IMMM and research network manager at the CNRS National Institute of Physics.
